

Manual Changes & Additions

Playing Music – Immediate Number Entry, p.9

You may press any digit key ① at the startup greeting screen to go directly to the hymn prompt and begin entering a number.

Tempo, p.10

The volume knob does not affect tempo. It is dedicated to changing the volume.

Instruments, p.14

When changing instruments on a single track, the track name is displayed on the left.

Other, p.19

If there is more than one alternate version of the melody, choose one by pressing Pause

| before starting to play, so that the screen displays OTHER 1, OTHER 2, etc.



Setup & Configuration, p.26

The currently selected item will be marked with black squares on either side.


Music Styles - Balance, p.27

Multiple options may be selected from this menu. Each choice will be marked with black squares on either side. The internal speaker amplifier profile, Percussion track muting, Orchestra

track level and Melody track level are set independently from each other.

Direct Amplifier Profile (new)



The internal speaker amplifier equalizer is bypassed and sound passes directly through the amplifier to the speaker with no alteration. This allows the maximum volume at the expense of reduced sound quality.

With Percussion / No Percussion, p.28

Select <With Percussion> to play with the Percussion mtrack. This is the factory default. Select <No Percussion> to turn off percussion.

Orchestra 100%, 80%, 60%, p.28

Select one of three options (100%, 80% or 60%) to set the volume on the Chords Track.

Melody 100%, 110% (new)

Select an option (100% or 110%) to set the volume on the Melody [4] track. <Melody 110%> increases the volume on the melody track by 6dB, emphasizing the melody on all the music. This makes it easier to follow along while singing and to learn new hymns and songs.

Music Styles - Plain or Special, p.28

The <Plain / Special> menu is now <Music Style>.


Music Styles – Key (new)

Select <Normal Key> to play every hymn or song in its default pitch. This is the factory default. Select <Key -1> or <Key -2> to lower the pitch on every hymn or song by one or two semitones. When playing individual selections you may press Raise (a) to bring the pitch back to its normal key.

Screen Backlight - Economy, p.30

The backlight turns off after 30 seconds of no user interaction.
